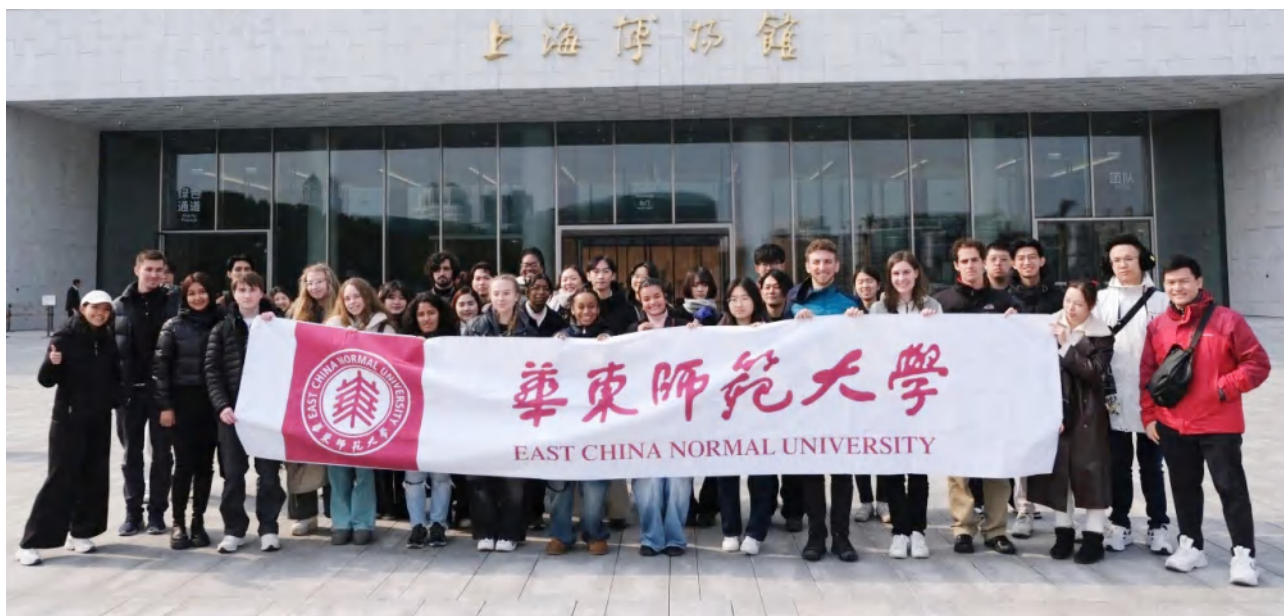
Global Education Center Student Events for Fall Semester

Insurance

According to the related Regulation issued by the Ministry of Education of China in 2007, all students studying in China for more than six months must purchase group comprehensive accident insurance in mainland China. If your study period exceeds six months, you must complete the insurance purchase

before registration. If you encounter difficulties, you can purchase the insurance on-site on the day of registration.

If your study period is less than six months, you can purchase insurance independently, but it must be verified by the university during registration.

Students need to pay upfront for treatment. After the treatment is completed, you can apply for reimbursement online.

Dorm Check-in

1. If you have successfully reserved on-campus dormitory accommodation, please bring your admission notice and original passport to the reception to complete the check-in process and collect your room key and "Registration Form of Temporary Residence."
2. Students will need to bring their own bedding (including mattress, sheets, duvet insert, duvet cover, pillow, pillowcase), towels, toothpaste, toothbrush, slippers, and other daily necessities.
- * From September 6 to 7, bedding will be available for purchase at the International Student Dormitory No.2 and the International Exchange Service Center.
3. After check-in, the dormitory does not provide daily cleaning services for rooms. Please prepare your own cleaning supplies and maintain cleanliness and tidiness within your room.

For more information about the dormitories, please refer to the respective "Instructions of Dorms."

Three Must-have Cards (SIM card, bank card, campus card)

A Chinese SIM card, a bank card, and an ECNU campus card are essential for every student, and these three cards will make your life in Shanghai more smooth. Let's take a look at how to apply for these three cards, as well as some reminders!



The SIM card must be the most important thing for everyone! With a Chinese SIM card, you can make phone calls, use data, bind various mobile apps, etc. in China. Let's take a quick look at the information of the telecommunication companies near the school



Putuo Campus:

- China Telecom: No. 788 Jinshajiang Road, 1st floor
- China Unicom: No. 423-3, Meiling South Road



Minhang Campus:

- China Telecom: 1st Floor, Building 7, Graduate Student Apartment (on campus)
- China Unicom: Room 108, Student Development Center, Minhang Campus (on campus)

Reminder

1. Required documents for SIM card application: passport
2. During the new student check-in period (9/6-9/7), staff from China Unicom and China Telecom will provide SIM card application services in the International Student Dorm No.2 and the International Exchange Service Center.
3. During the registration days (9/8-9/10), staff from China Unicom and China Telecom are coming on site to provide SIM card application services.
4. You need to have a Chinese cell phone number before you can apply for a bank card.

**Bank Card**

It is necessary to apply for a Chinese bank card. Alipay and WeChat need to be bound to a Chinese bank card in order to use them properly in China. Bank of China and Industrial and Commercial Bank of China have several branches near the campus, so you can decide which one to apply for according to your needs.

Reminder

1. Documents required for bank card application: passport, admission letter, Registration Form of Temporary Residence, and Chinese cell phone number.
2. Bank of China and ICBC can accept card applications from international students whose study period is less than 6 months.
3. Scholarship students must apply for an ICBC account.
4. You can apply for a Bank of China bank card on campus during the registration (9/8-9/10).
5. It takes several days to activate the bank card. It is recommended that you can use cash before your bank card is activated.

**Campus Card**

All new students will receive a campus card when you come for the registration. With the campus card, you will be able to use it for entering the campus, and making purchase in the store and cafeterias on campus.

If you accidentally lose your campus card, you can go to the Campus Card Center present your admission notice and pay RMB 20 yuan to get a replacement card.

If you don't have enough balance on your campus card, you can use WeChat to scan the QR code below to top up your card.

Express Delivery Service

Both Putuo and Minhang campuses have Cainiao post stations on campus, where students can conveniently collect and send packages. When you shop online, you can write your own personal information and the mailing address based on your campus. You can easily pick up your parcels from the Post Station with the shelf code, which is sent through message.

Surrounding transportation

The transportation around the campuses is convenient. Metro Line 15 can even connect both campuses of ECNU and also allows you to transfer to various metro lines, making it easy to travel around Shanghai. You can search “乘车码” on Alipay, and swipe the corresponding QR code for the subway to ride.



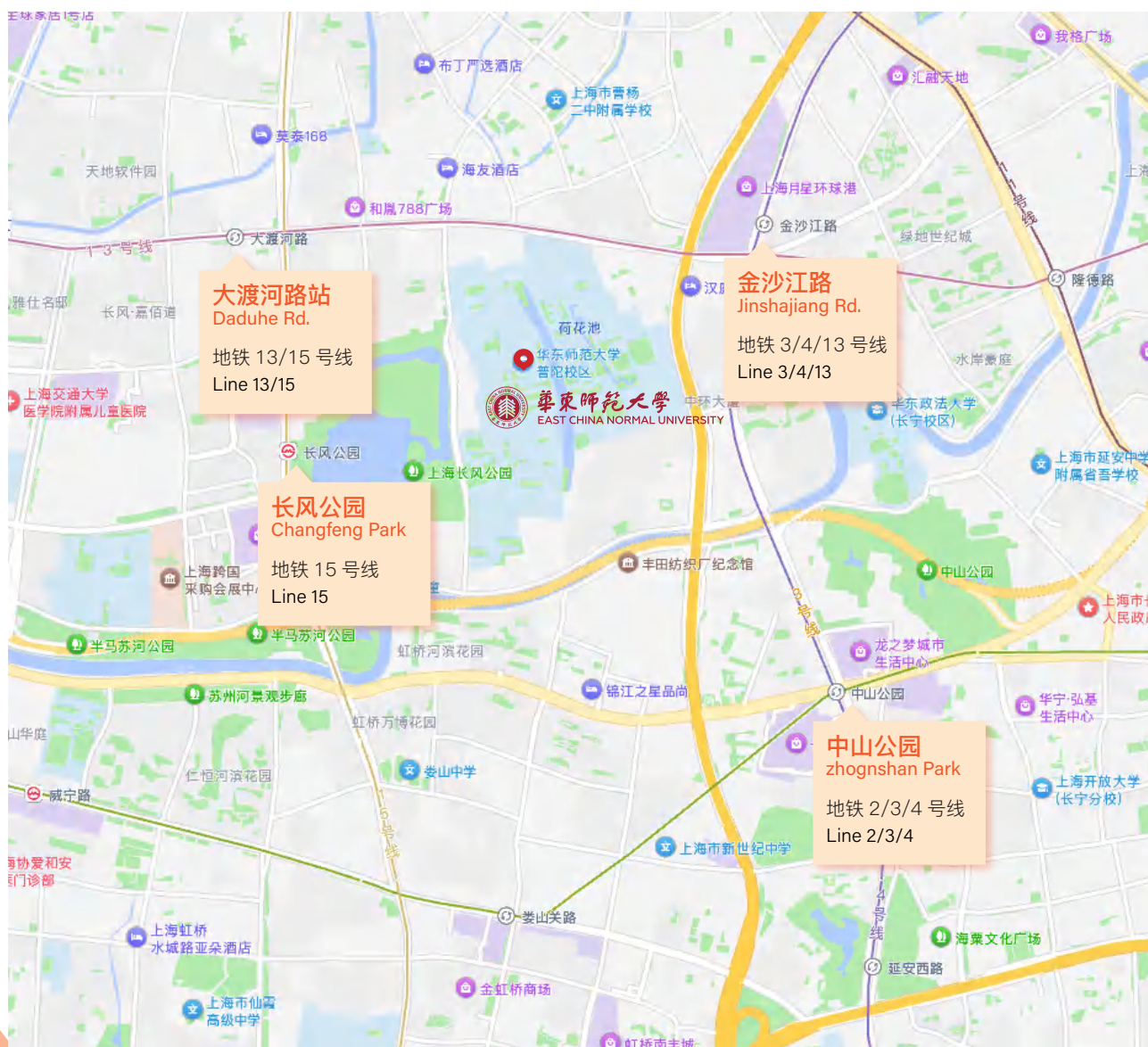
Putuo Campus

- Metro Line 15: Chang Feng Park station

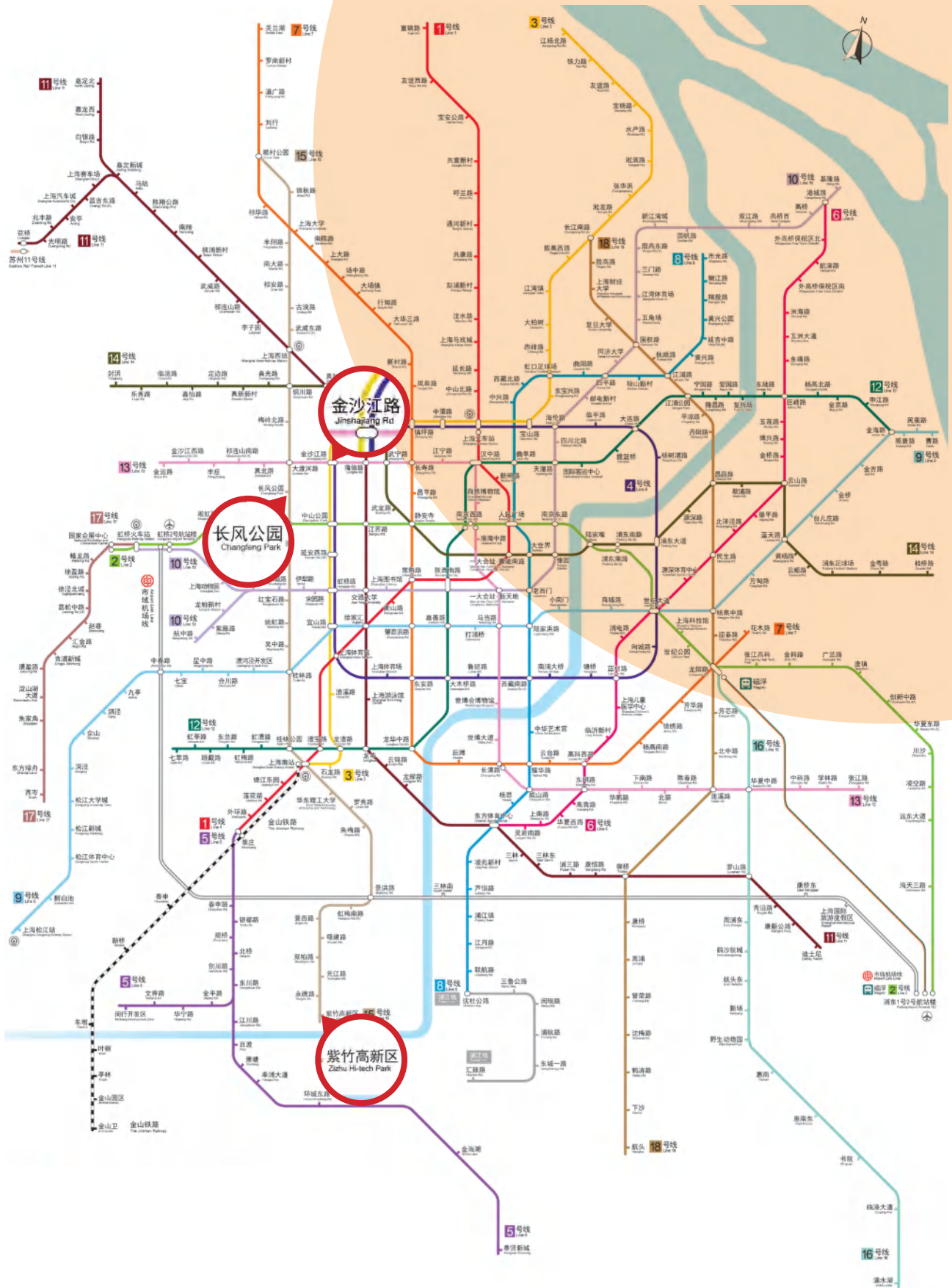


Minhang Campus

Shanghai Public Transportation

Taxis

(1) Taxi Fares:

5:00 AM - 11:00 PM: 14-16 yuan for the first 3 kilometers, then 2.7 yuan per kilometer thereafter

11:00 PM - 5:00 AM: 30% surcharge

(2) Important Notes

Please use licensed taxis (with a light on top) and avoid private vehicles soliciting passengers on the street.

Please ask the driver for an invoice before exiting the vehicle. If necessary, the vehicle can be traced using the invoice.

(3) Payment Methods

Taxi fares can be paid in cash, via Alipay, or WeChat Pay. Some vehicles accept card payments.

Subway

Including maglev, Shanghai has a total of 20 lines and 508 stations.

(1) Subway fares

0-6 kilometers: 3 yuan; 1 yuan added for every 10 kilometers beyond 6 kilometers

(2) Subway Payment Methods

Subway fares can be paid using the Shanghai Public Transport Card (available for purchase at subway stations, a prepaid card), the Metropolis app (requires linking to a bank card or Alipay), or by searching for "乘车码" on Alipay/WeChat (WeChat and Alipay require linking to a bank card). Additionally, cash can be used at self-service ticket machines in subway stations.



Shared bicycles

Shared bicycles are available on and off campus, and require a designated app to unlock. Before use, you must first link the app to your bank card.



*Please do not ride too fast. Be careful on roads both on and off campus.

As the most popular communication app in China, WeChat not only allows you to communicate with friends, classmates, and teachers online and share your life in Moments, but also enables online and offline payments and shopping possible.



Alipay

With Alipay, you can leave your wallet at home. It allows you to pay for anything and everything, from street food to luxury shopping, and even split the bills with your friends with just a few taps on your phone.

You can also use Alipay to scan the QR code on the blue sharing bike, which will help you to stroll around the campus and also connect to your final destination after you getting of the subway.

DIDI

The Chinese version of Uber, is like having a personal chauffeur at your fingertips. Just tap your way to a convenient and affordable ride.

China's online shopping paradise, offering everything from clothing and accessories to food, from Chinese local gifts to imported products. Coupled with China's fast and efficient delivery service, it allows you to enjoy the joy of shopping without leaving your home.



Dianping

When you arrive in a new city, do you get lost about where to visit and what to eat? Dianping allows you to unlock unlimited food options and convenient travel guides with just several clicks, letting you experience a whole new way of life.



Meituan

Meituan offers food delivery and fruit and vegetable express services, allowing you to enjoy various delicacies at home. Meituan's taxi and bike-sharing features also provide you with an additional platform for transportation options. Don't you deserve to have an app that combines all these practical functions together?



Ctrip

Imagine having a travel genie who can book your flights/train tickets, find the best hotels and plan your entire itinerary with just a few clicks - that's what Ctrip does. It's like having a personal travel assistant in your pocket!

Safety Reminder

Safety is always the prerequisite for embarking on this journey. Whether it's daily commuting, campus life, or dealing with emergencies, having a basic understanding of safety knowledge will help you adapt to new environments with greater ease.



Healthy Lifestyle

Shanghai experiences distinct seasons, with hot summers, cold and damp winters, and frequent weather changes in spring and autumn. It is recommended to pay attention to weather changes, adjust clothing and diet accordingly, maintain a healthy routine, and keep fit.



Going Out Safely:

Shanghai is a safe city, but it is still not advisable to go out alone at night or venture into unfamiliar and remote areas. It is also recommended to avoid overcrowded places to prevent any opportunistic incidents.



Property Safety

It is advisable not to carry large amounts of cash or valuable items when going out. Mobile payments are well-developed in China, and it is recommended to try the convenience of "one phone for all transactions."



Safe Travel

Please strictly follow traffic regulations and avoid jaywalking when going out. If you need to purchase motorcycles or electric scooter, make sure to register them with the public security department and legally use them on the road.



Taxi Ride

If taking a taxi, it is recommended to ask for a receipt from the driver and keep it. In case of losing items in the car, or being dissatisfied with the service and needing to file a complaint, the receipt is an important proof.



Electrical Appliances

When using various household electrical appliances, remember to turn off the power when you finish using. Never charge electric scooter indoors or in hallways, as it can easily cause fires.



Beware of Scams

Be cautious of false advertisements and scam information online, and do not be deceived by "cheap deals"; do NOT transfer money to any strangers privately. It is recommended to contact your teacher for guidance and assistance.



Stay Away from Drugs

In China, any involvement with drugs (including marijuana) is strictly prohibited! Remember to stay away from drugs. Also, be cautious not to accept food or beverages from strangers.
